Our Brandeis season is set to begin with all the programs that attract our members: stimulating study groups, “Breakfast with Brandeis” open meetings and enjoyable fundraisers for our enlightenment and entertainment.

Museum trips in Miami and Palm Beach, Folk Singers, dynamic performers, Music, Music, Music and vibrant speakers all contribute to an exciting year while supporting an innovative, highly respected University and Research institution.

Supporting this notion of a special university that provides a world class education to talented students have been recent major gifts: Benefactor, Edward Fine committed \$5 Million Dollars to maintaining Brandeis’ mission to educate the best students without regard to financial need.
